For Book #1—

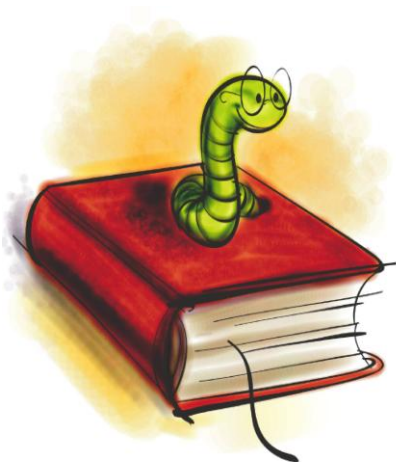
Make a Book Award (directions and pattern are attached).

5. Color and cut out the award.

Story Quilt Square:

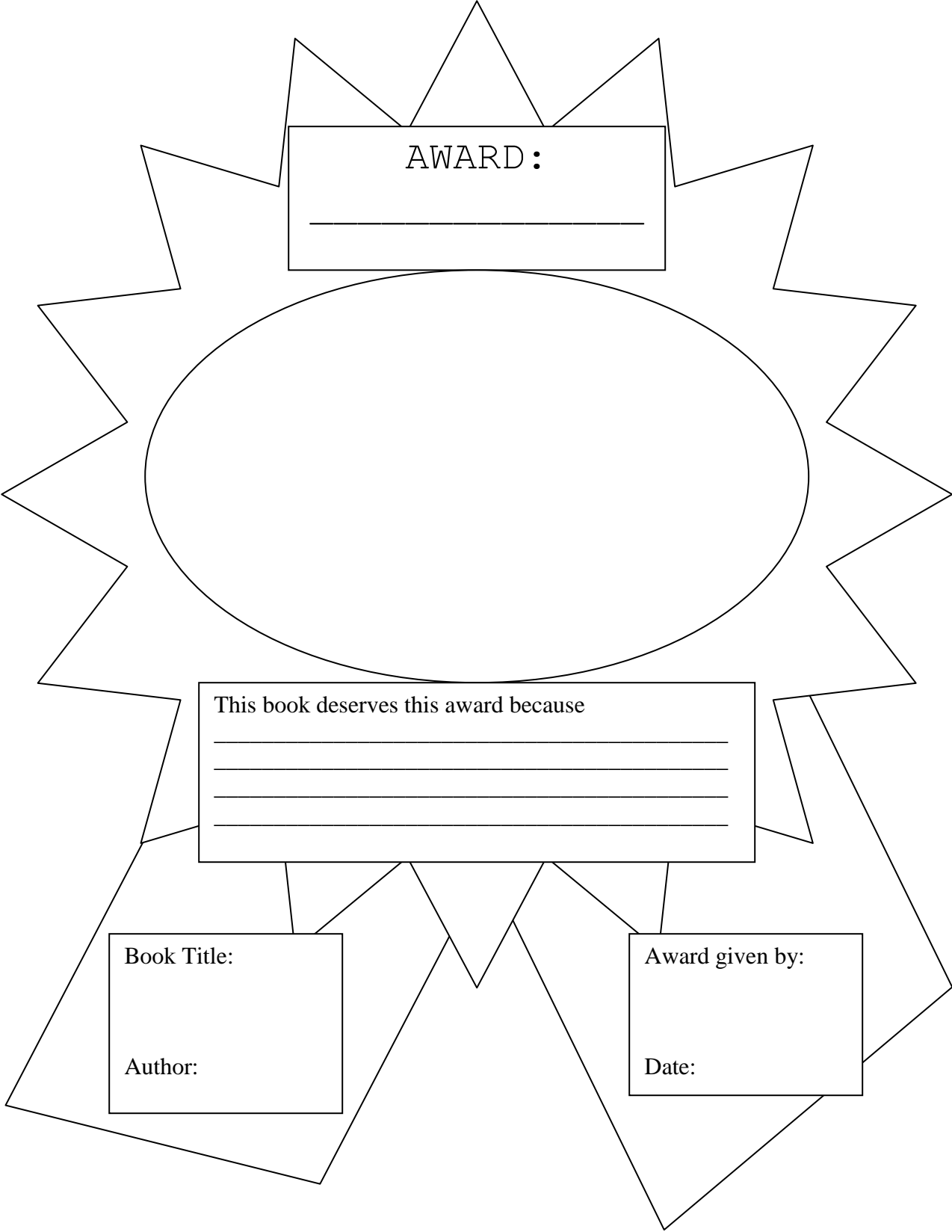
1. In the middle square, write the book title and author. Draw and color a picture about the book.
2. In each of the four corners, draw a picture that represents an important object or character from the book. Label and color your pictures.
3. Add stitches around the center square with a crayon or marker.
