

**Entering 8th Grade (2020-2021)
Middle School Language Arts Summer Reading**

Required Reading: You will read **two books** for summer reading before 7th grade. You will take an AR quiz on **each** book. If you write (by hand) one page of notes for each book, you are free to use those notes on the AR quizzes. You will write a paper for **each** of the books.

1. Read *Saint Francis of Assisi* by G.K. Chesterton.
 - a. Write an 800-1000-word paper. Evaluate the plot, the main characters, and events that take place in the book. Give your opinion of the book. Use quotes from the text (at least ten). Your paper should be written in paragraph form with an introduction and conclusion. Cite page numbers for your quotes. Make sure to check your grammar, spelling, and punctuation. Include a word count.
2. Read a book of your choice from the below list.
 - a. Write an 800-1000-word paper. Evaluate the plot, the main characters, and events that take place in the book. Give your opinion of the book. Use quotes from the text (at least ten). Your paper should be written in paragraph form with an introduction and conclusion. Cite page numbers for your quotes. Check your grammar, spelling, and punctuation. Include a word count.
