

First Grade Weekly

Hello Parents! Here is a snapshot of the lessons and activities that we will be covering this week.

Reading: Your child will continue to review things they learned in Kindergarten. This will ensure they are off to a great start when we begin our First-Grade materials.

Phonics: Students will identify, decode and build one-syllable words. We will focus on the sounds of the following letters: Nn – Zz.

Handwriting: We will work on letter and word spacing, paying close attention to using the proper grip on our pencils. We will practice writing letters over the next week. Your child will start using their handwriting workbook after we complete our Kindergarten review.



Writing: This week we will continue working on their alphabet book. Workshop is a special time that we will focus on writing activities allowing one-on-one time for student evaluations.

Religion: This week we will focus on the special times the Church celebrates throughout the Church year.



Math: We continue using hands-on activities to understand and explain that addition is based on putting together parts in order to make a whole. We will discuss related facts and learn a four-step process for solving word problems. Students will end the week reviewing all the concepts taught in Chapter 1.
